Who we are looking for



A series of four weekly 20-30 minute STEM mentoring video-conferencing interactions (two hours max). A series orientation and first meeting with the classroom educator at the very beginning. A culminating event at the end brings together project partners to celebrate, debrief and figure out next steps to ensure lasting impact. Details will be provided. Participating educators have an opportunity to apply for a mini grant to support the integration of ideas and/or strategies from the mentoring sessions into classroom practice.

How to prepare

We will be there each step of the way. Dig out your inner 9-14 year-old and be ready to share your stories of first spark of interest and mentors that captured your admiration. We'll let you know what to expect and the STEM mentoring video-conferencing interactions have structured prompts to help get things rolling.
